The Windsor Regional Library



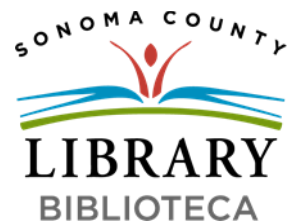


This is my library, Windsor Regional Library. We come to the library to access information and services. There are books I can read, information I can research, and programs and services in which I can participate.

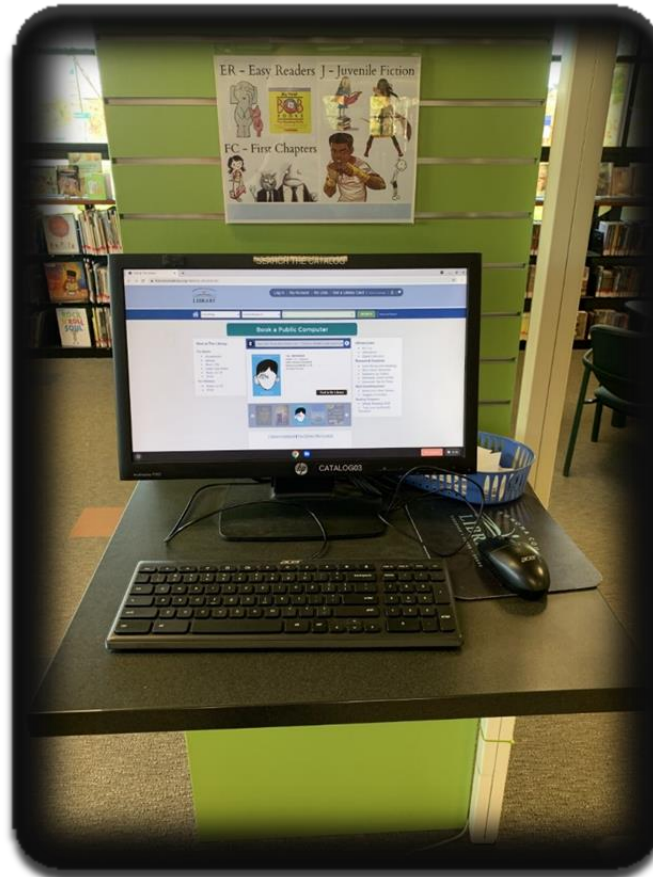
This is Terra, the Children's librarian at my library.
